CAFF is a coalition of people from many different backgrounds who share one aim: to **stop factory farms** from being built or expanding.

We are made up of:

- Local residents directly affected by factory farm proposals
- People currently facing planning applications in their area
- Others concerned about the impacts of factory farming on health, the environment, and animal welfare



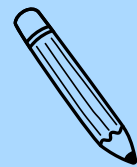
At the heart of CAFF are communities - people who care about where they live and want a say in what happens there.

WHAT DOES CAFF DO?

CAFF has a core team that supports local communities to **challenge factory farm planning applications**, with the aim of stopping them being approved.

Our support can include:

- Helping communities organise and campaign locally
- Providing advice on objecting to planning applications
- Supporting legal challenges where necessary



Our support is **free** to local communities, made possible by public donations.

CAFF'S TRACK RECORD

CAFF launched in April 2025. Since then:

- We have successfully delayed, reversed, or won against every planning application we have campaigned on.
- More than 70 factory farm planning applications and environmental permits have been challenged with CAFF's support.

In three cases, applications were initially approved. We didn't stop there. Legal action was taken every time - and **we won every single case**.



We win by **working together** with local communities, environmental experts and consultants, lawyers, active campaigners and journalists.
